## RECOMMENDATION

Approval of the application for Colorado Parks and Wildlife Impact Assistance Grant Application.

## BACKGROUND

**Legislative declaration:** The general assembly hereby recognizes that withdrawal of lands from county tax rolls (tax exemption) for the purpose of wildlife conservation and public recreation may create financial impacts on counties in which such lands are located. The general assembly further recognizes that such withdrawal may necessitate financial support and assistance by the state.

Any County in which land is owned by Colorado Parks and Wildlife is eligible to receive annually Impact Assistance Grant funding. Colorado Parks and Wildlife is committed to being a good neighbor in the communities where they own land in fee title for the benefit of wildlife and outdoor recreation.

In order to receive a grant, a County must apply no later than March 6, 2026.

## FISCAL IMPACT

Colorado Parks and Wildlife provide the acres for parcels owned in fee title by tax area. The Assessor provides the current mill levies and assessed value per acre, which is calculated per the Department of Property Taxation. I am requesting \$2,439.72 from the Colorado Parks and Wildlife. There are no matching grants. The money helps to offset the cost of general fund services to administer property tax records for Colorado Parks and Wildlife owned land.
