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## RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of Resolution #26-27, a Resolution Authorizing the Disposal of Seven Clear Creek County Vehicles.

## BACKGROUND

The Public Works Division is disposing of assets that are not used on a regular basis, expensive to maintain, and/or are no longer serviceable. The Board of County Commissioners typically authorizes the disposal of assets of this nature by Resolution. The vehicles and equipment recommended for disposal at this time are:

## ANALYSIS

The Public Works Fleet Division has determined that the seven vehicles should be disposed of via public auction. The vehicles and equipment included in this request are expensive to maintain and no longer being used. The disposal of similar assets in recent years suggests that selling these assets at a public auction will generate more revenue and require less staff time than selling them via advertised closed bid.



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## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The Public Works Road & Bridge Department budgeted the sale of assets (revenue) in the amount of \$50,000 in the approved 2026 budget. The proceeds from the sale of the vehicles and equipment shown above will be credited to this account.
