Expand Childcare Access

Support the expansion of childcare access throughout the County by partnering with local organizations and exploring options to increase funding for childcare scholarships.

Strengthen Organizational Resilience and Regional Coordination

Build organizational resiliency, succession-ready capacity, and advocacy with state and federal stakeholder agencies regarding operations and capital planning related to Interstate 70.

Diversify County Revenue and Mitigate External Impacts

Position the County, through legislative advocacy, the use of professional lobbyists, and other legislative strategies, to explore more diverse revenue options for counties and pursue direct mitigation of impacts on county services resulting from state and federal actions.

Advance Economic Development and Diversification

Continue building economic development capacity across the county and align goals to provide a clear path forward for increased economic diversification and long-term resiliency.

Support Regional Housing Solutions

Continue supporting the development and maturation of the Clear Creek Regional Housing Authority.

Enhance Wildfire Mitigation and Forest Health

Enhance wildfire mitigation capacity through collaboration with the CSU Extension Office and explore the development of a Forest Health Special District.

Foster a Collaborative and Innovative Organizational Culture

Continue cultivating a creative, collaborative, innovative, and safe work environment where healthy disagreement is encouraged and protected through board policies and training, with the goal of strengthening trust with staff and the public.

Increase Community Engagement and Transparency

Increase opportunities for direct community engagement by hosting more town halls and public forums throughout the County to share information, gather feedback, and strengthen relationships with residents.
