NEW INDIVIDUAL/HOUSEHOLD ASSISTANCE *in cooperation with the Grand Foundation*

Clear Creek County residents/households impacted by COVID-19 are eligible for local financial support to pay utility bills (water, sewer, gas, trash, internet), childcare, pre-k tuition, transportation, mental health support, rent/mortgage and eviction related charges. The Clear Creek County Emergency COVID-19 Assistance Fund is designed to aid those who have lost wages, had a reduction in work hours, or other income hardships caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
