CLEAR CREEK COUNTY RECEIVES ADDITIONAL \$100,000 FROM COLORADO COVID RELIEF FUND TO HELP RESIDENTS

County Recovery Coordinator, Alyssa Dinberg, reports, “We are extremely grateful for this additional money from the Colorado COVID Relief Fund. It will allow us to continue to assist county residents who have experienced financial hardships due to COVID-19.” As the December 30th deadline for disbursement for the first allocation of CARES funding draws near, the original \$50,000 amount has been depleted with a significant number of unmet needs.

Clear Creek County residents/households impacted by COVID-19 are eligible for financial support to assist with:

- utility bills (water, sewer, gas, trash, internet)
- childcare
- transportation
- mental health support
- rent/mortgage/lot lease
- eviction related charges

Awards will be given out on a first come, first serve basis with exception given in emergency situations. The fund is administered through a partnership with the Grand Foundation.

Led by an executive committee in coordination with the Governor’s Office, the Colorado COVID Relief Fund was developed to raise and coordinate allocation of funds based on COVID-19 prevention, impact and recovery needs of community-based organizations in Colorado. The Fund is organized to ensure that the most acute community needs across the state are being addressed and that community voice is reflected in all funding decisions made over time.

As part of the CLEAR CREEK CARES ABOUT RESIDENTS assistance program, 200 COVID-19 SUPPORT KITS were assembled and distributed to local individuals and families throughout the county last week. Kits included masks, hand sanitizer made by Tommyknocker’s, disinfectant wipes and other essentials.
