CLEAR CREEK RECEIVES ADDITIONAL \$100,000 COVID RELIEF FUNDING for INDIVIDUAL/HOUSEHOLD ASSISTANCE *in partnership with the Grand Foundation*

Clear Creek County residents/households impacted by COVID-19 are eligible for local financial support to pay for:

- utility bills (water, sewer, gas, trash, internet)
- childcare
- mental health support
- transportation
- rent/mortgage/lot lease
- eviction related charges

Applications awarded on a first come, first serve basis, with exceptions for emergency situations, until the additional \$100,000 is exhausted.
