

## CLEAR CREEK COUNTY'S COVID-19 VACCINATION GOAL

To provide vaccinations to all eligible members of the Clear Creek County community who want them, as quickly and safely as possible, following all applicable guidance.

### VACCINATION UPDATES FOR THE WEEK OF JANUARY 11, 2021

*Updates will be made on the Monday of each week.*

- We recently learned from the State that CLEAR CREEK COUNTY WILL NOT BE RECEIVING ANY ADDITIONAL VACCINE THIS WEEK.
- Therefore, THERE ARE NO VACCINATION CLINICS SCHEDULED IN CLEAR CREEK COUNTY THIS WEEK.
- All of the doses of the COVID-19 vaccine that we have received have been administered.
- Currently, vaccination appointments are being scheduled for at least two weeks from now.

#### HOW DO I GET REGISTERED FOR THE VACCINE?

We continue to collect PRE-REGISTRATION information for those interested in receiving the vaccine:

- PLEASE NOTE: After you are pre-registered, when your vaccination phase/category becomes eligible, you will be notified via email (or phone if you are not able to receive email) and will receive a link to the online self-scheduling system.

#### WHAT VACCINATION PHASE ARE WE IN RIGHT NOW?

In Clear Creek County, we are still in **VACCINATION PHASE 1 / 1B** (above the dotted line on the CDPHE chart). The current priority groups per the State are:

- Full-time Clear Creek County residents aged 70+
  - People employed within Clear Creek County whose jobs are in categories 1A and 1B – all first responders (EMS, Firefighters, Law Enforcement), health care workers with direct contact with COVID-19 patients, and all other health care workers (home health, hospice, dentists, pharmacists, etc.)
- ⇒ If you are employed in a 1A or 1B job NOT operating in Clear Creek County, you need to contact your employer and/or county of employment for getting vaccinated. This applies even if you are a Clear Creek County resident.

#### CAN I PRE-REGISTER FOR A FUTURE CATEGORY or PHASE?

Currently you can pre-register for categories in PHASE 1, above the dotted line, ONLY. See the CDPHE chart below for details. You can complete the electronic pre-registration form even if you are not eligible for the current category, as long as the category is in Phase 1. When you pre-register, check the appropriate category for your situation and you will be notified when registration opens up for that category.

#### WHY DO WE HAVE TO WAIT?

Our allotment of vaccine doses from the State of Colorado is based on our number of primary residents, as well estimates of those employed in the county.

The county receives a limited amount of vaccine from the state, typically weekly, with three to four days' notice. We currently receive the Moderna vaccine, which requires 2 doses one month apart.

We appreciate your ongoing patience as we continue to navigate through the changing vaccination phases, categories and logistical challenges.

As we receive new information, we will update our website to provide details regarding the next eligible group for vaccinations and clinic details
