

CLEAR CREEK COUNTY COVID-19 VACCINATION UPDATES FOR THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 15, 2021

GOAL: To provide vaccinations to all those eligible who want them, as quickly and safely as possible, following all applicable guidance.

- According to the State's **COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution Plan**, those in Phase 1B.2 are now eligible to receive the vaccine. Phase 1B.2 includes:
 - Coloradans aged 65 or older
 - Colorado's Pre-K through 12th grade educators and childcare workers
- Vaccines continue to be available to those aged 70 or older and others in Phase 1B.1, as well as those in Phase 1A.
- This statewide phased approach is in place so that those in the highest risk categories are vaccinated before moving to the next phase. View the phases at: <https://covid19.colorado.gov/for-coloradans/vaccine/vaccine-for-coloradans>

- This is the ninth week of COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Clear Creek County.
 - All available appointments for this week have been filled.
 - We continue to receive small shipments of vaccines most weeks and demand for the vaccine still exceeds the supply.
 - To be notified when vaccination appointments are available for your phase, please follow the instructions below.
 - If you submitted the **Google Vaccination Interest Form** (below), your information remains on file and you will be notified when the next clinic becomes available.
 - The County is close to completing vaccinations for those in Phase 1A and 1B.1. If you are in these phases, but have not yet been vaccinated and wish to be, please follow the instructions below.

HOW DO I GET THE VACCINE?

The County continues to collect information for individuals interested in receiving the vaccine in any phase. **Please be aware that it may be weeks or months until your phase becomes eligible and vaccines are available.** For current statewide phases, visit: <https://covid19.colorado.gov/for-coloradans/vaccine/vaccine-for-coloradans>.

To indicate your interest in receiving COVID-19 vaccinations from Clear Creek County Public Health:

1. **Complete and submit this online *Google Vaccination Interest Form*:**

- After you submit this online form (one per person), you will receive an instant pop-up receipt.
- A short while later you will receive an email confirmation of the information you submitted.
- Be sure to check your check your Junk/Spam folders.

If you do not have internet access, please leave a message on the **COUNTY COVID HEALTH LINE at 303-670-7528** and you will receive a call back.

2. **Self-Schedule.** When vaccines are available for your phase AND a clinic is scheduled, you will be notified by email (or phone if you are not able to receive email) with a link to the online self-scheduling system, including clinic details.

- After you receive your first dose, we will schedule your second dose 28 days later. We currently receive the Moderna vaccine, which requires two doses 28 days apart. You must be available for both doses.
- **You must have an appointment to be vaccinated.**
