SUBJECT: Level CLEAR Designation

Beginning on May 16, 2021, Clear Creek County will move to Level CLEAR, which eliminates capacity restrictions for businesses. However, per local ordinance, face covering requirements still apply and are required in all public places.

Despite the removal of capacity restrictions, it is highly recommended that businesses continue to follow the best practices and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC):
