CLEAR CREEK COUNTY RESCINDS FACE MASK ORDER

At a Special Meeting held on May 20, 2021, the Clear Creek County Board of County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Health (BOH), voted 2 to 1 to approve BOH Resolution 21-04 which rescinds all aspects of the BOH Standing Public Health Order 21-03 relating to face coverings, but maintains all aspects of the Order applicable to contact tracing. Resolution 21-04 went into effect at 11:59pm on Thursday, May 20, 2021.

Now, in Clear Creek County, in accordance with the recent State of Colorado Public Health Orders relating to face coverings (Executive Order of the Governor D 21-103 and Second Amended Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Order 20-38), fully vaccinated people are no longer required to wear face masks in most settings, except where required by the State Orders, or by local businesses and workplaces. For those not yet vaccinated, state officials and the Clear Creek County Public & Environmental Health Department suggest that face masks still be worn in indoor settings around others. Individuals and businesses in Clear Creek should follow the face covering requirements set forth in the State Orders. In some settings, such as prisons, jails, health care facilities and schools, Colorado will still require masks unless people can prove they are vaccinated. Businesses and other workplaces can choose whether or not to require masks for worker safety and other reasons.
