Clear Creek County Sheriff's Office Launches "SafeCall", New Program Lets Residents Call-in, Get Daily Information

June 7, 2016 - **Clear Creek County Communications, Colo.** – The Clear Creek County Sheriff's Office recently began a public safety and community outreach program for County residents, known as "SafeCall." Working in partnership with the County's Department of Health & Human Services, Clear Creek EMS, CCC Fire Authority, and the Georgetown and Idaho Springs Police departments, the program allows any County resident to call into the CCC Sheriff's Office Communications Center daily. When they call, residents will receive public safety announcements, information about crime prevention, fire safety updates and much more.

Designed primarily for residents who live alone or in remote areas, those interested can sign up by calling the Sheriff's Office Communications Division, at (303) 679-2393. Residents are asked to call in, every day, between 6 a.m. – 11 a.m.—and, those who forget will get a call from the Communications Center Team to check on you!
