ORDINANCE

REGULATING PARKING ON COUNTY MAINTAINED ROADWAYS

O-84-2A


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clear Creek County, Colorado has determined that the public health and safety of County citizens is and has been endangered by vehicles remaining on or blocking, or impeding the flow of private or public traffic on Clear Creek County maintained roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the County to adopt a comprehensive Ordinance regarding the towing of vehicles left unattended or blocking, or impeding the flow of private or public vehicle traffic on any County maintained roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Clear Creek County, Colorado, that:

1. No person in charge of a motor vehicle operated on any Clear Creek County maintained roadway shall allow the vehicle to remain on, or block, or impede the flow of private or public vehicle traffic on said roadway or park said vehicle on said roadway.
2. When a vehicle is parked on, or becomes or remains immobile on any County maintained roadway, or blocks or impedes the flow of public or private vehicle traffic, the Clear Creek County Road supervisor or his agent shall cause the vehicle to be towed to a vehicle storage lot.
3. Penalties for violation of this Ordinance shall be as determined by the appropriate Court pursuant to Colorado Statutes. The charges for towing any vehicle under this Ordinance shall be assessed against the owner of the vehicle and shall be paid in addition to any penalties set by the Court.
