

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 03

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CONTROL AND REGULATION OF THE MOVEMENT AND PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY THE COUNTY OF CLEAR CREEK, STATE OF COLORADO; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1995 EDITION OF THE "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITIES;" REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Title 30, Article 15, Part 4; and Title 42, Article 4, C.R.S. 1973 as amended, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to adopt ordinances to control and regulate the movement and parking of motor vehicles on public property; and

WHEREAS, Title 33, Article 14, Part 1, C.R.S, as amended, authorizes regulations on the use of snowmobiles; and

WHEREAS, Title 30, Article 15, Section 402, C.R.S, as amended, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to execute the penalty assessment procedure provided in §16-2-201, C.R.S. as amended, and to adopt a graduated fine schedule for violations of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the adoption of a traffic ordinance is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Clear Creek County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held a public meeting on this ordinance for a first reading February 24, 1998 and a second reading and adoption on March 24, 1998.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the County to amend a portion of Section 6.1. Traffic Fine Schedule.

WHEREAS, the following amendment was introduced and testimony was heard at regular meetings of the Board of County Commissioners of Clear Creek County on August 17, 1999 and September 14, 1999; with publication of such meeting and the full text of the amendment appearing in the *Clear Creek Courant* on September 1, 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CLEAR CREEK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:
